Designer Henrietta Samuels' new 'Keep and Love' collection is fabulously feminine, featuring lace, bows, and baby blooms. Best of all, the colours are my favourite and among the most versatile in fashion: pink, peach, lavender, and gold. Love em!



«BE A SWEETHEART»

How could you resist such lovely one-off kimono fabric bows and antique brooch adornments? These Sweetheart slingbacks (\$675) have soft leather uppers, linings, and soles. Experiment with tying the pink ribbon in myriad ways. For the bow hoarder - the back of the heel features another bow, flat and folded.



«ALL LACED UP»

The thought of petal-shaped, vegetable tanned leather and silk ties enwrapping your feet sounds grandiose, and that is exactly what these Darling sandals (\$630) do. Vintage embellishments sit on top of the leather, along with gold brooches on the heel. With a heel height of 90mm, you won't break your ankle walking around in them.



«FLOWER POWER»

Wooden block heels make Amour (\$630) easy to wear and just as attractive as her 'Keep and Love' sisters. Floral adornments accessorise these structured sandals with delicate bursts of colour. This pair would look great with a 50s style skirt or dress. The lining and sole are made of leather.



«RADIATE STYLE»

These Belle court heels (\$720) are probably my favourite pick of 'Keep and Love'. Radiating antiquarian simplicity, the shoe's metallic purple colour adds diva to this otherwise classic design. The bows on the toe box are sourced from vintage fabric. Similarly, feminine fabric enrobes the thick heels.
